***Elections for Parish Council

Every 4 years the Residents of Brent Knoll have the opportunity to choose their Parish Council for the forthcoming 4 years. The Parish Council is made up of 11 members who take local decisions about the village and manage various parts of the infrastructure including the village green, the Play equipment, the toilet block and car park and in addition manage the contracts for verge and general maintenance of the village etc. The Parish Council meets on the first Wednesday of each month except August and part of its role is for consultation on local planning applications.

It is very important that the Parish Council has member's from across the village community and it has a broad spectrum of membership so that it fully reflects the attitudes and ideas of the whole village.
